



Pass The...

Engage children in turn-taking activities by having them pass an object back and forth or down a line with peers. For example, pass an eraser, ball, small toy, car, or anything you have accessible in the moment from one child to the next down a line or around a circle. Or back and forth between two peers.

More Support: Help children hand a peer an object, roll a ball between two peers, or narrate as you pass an item to a child.

Prompt Children to Consider the Feelings of Others

"I see you passed it to (Child)! Look at them smiling! They seem happy to get the ball. Nice sharing! Now it's headed back to you!"

"Look at (Child). How do you think they're feeling? How do you think they'd feel if you passed them the car?"
